Welcome to the 2023 KCIC "LAST HOORH" Camporee. First and foremost I hope all of you are doing well. It's sad to say that following this camporee we will be disbanding the KCIC after 50 plus years. I hope that many of you will be able to join us and meet with friends and families that have gathered over the years for this final camporee.

We put together a schedule for you. If you were here 20 years ago it was a full schedule of activities and a lot of work. We stepped back a little so we, as a committee, can also enjoy our final year visiting with all of you. We want to make your stay in Wisconsin relaxing, enjoyable and memorable.

First and foremost is to make your reservation for a campsite, cabin or hotel room in the area. The information on campsites and hotels are included in this mailing.

ALL CAMPSITE RESERVATIONS MUST BE MADE BY April 1, 2023

We will have our standard activities and a few meals planned for you. Also, there are many places and things for you to explore in Sturgeon Bay and the Door County area. The Knights of Columbus of Sturgeon Bay will do a FISH BOIL dinner for us. We also scheduled a Packer Tour of Lambeau Field and the Packer Hall of Fame.

The Fish Boil will be held on Friday night. The Fish Boil includes: Fish, Potatoes, Onions, Carrots, Applesauce, Cole Slaw, Rye Bread, Coffee, and Milk and finished off with a Door County Cherry Desert.

Cost is \$22.00 per person.

The Packer Tour will be 6 hours from leaving the campground until your return. The Lambeau Field tour is approximately 90 minutes and a walking distance of one mile. It includes the Lambeau Field Atrium, East Side Premium Seating, South End Zone Rooftop, South End Clubs, and the Players Tunnel and Sideline. Following the tour, you will be able to walk through the Packer Hall of Fame. The Hall of Fame tour is a self-guided tour and will take approximately one hour of your time or you can visit the Packer Pro Shop. Also, we plan to stop for lunch which is not included but on your own.

Cost is \$47.00 per person.

The Golf Outing will be a nine-hole Best Ball Outing. The outing will be held at Idlewild Wild Golf Course. Price includes golf, cart, prize holes and lunch following. If you wish to play another nine holes, it is on your own.

Cost is \$37.00 per person.

The Sandwich Platter Dinner: This is a casual dinner of your choice of a Pulled Pork Sandwich or a Shredded Turkey Sandwich. This will include a bag of chips, cookie and bottled water.

Cost is \$7.00 per person.

Craft Party: This activity is sponsored by Tranquil Timbers Campground. Join them Saturday morning for fun crafting projects. Pick one and get to work! Crafts will include: wood art, tile, pottery, wind chimes, stonework, canvas, painting, kids' activities and more. We will also be providing light snacks (rolls, bars and drinks). We will need to know which activity you would like to do so they will have enough for everyone to participate.
